New Castle Circle – Ken Patched the Hole, still needs to be graded properly. – Ken will complete this in the next 3 weeks.

Pool Paver Installation - Ken and Skip to locate pipe and cap off prior to scheduling installation – Skip had initially approved a check to be written but asked Marsha to hold off as we are trying to get a copy of the plans from Hefler since the city does not have them to review drainage. Need to move drain line?

Pool Fence – Needs cementing on several areas – Marsha will add to George's maintenance List

Beautify Sterling Entrance - Planting still needs to be done. It was suggested we paint the light green word "Ivanhoe" new light color to match new exterior wall paint and add solar lighting – Ken send a pic of entryway to Jen Illing for what she thinks would be the best options for long term low maintenance Vegetation.

Exterior Walls/ Paint and Clean - Kathryn Saidak attended meeting to discuss Waterford residents matching paint to Hawkes Bluff darker color for exterior walls, motion was made and approved for darker paint with light stripe. – Ken got quote for perimeter walls. – Ken received quotes from CRS Management for Ivanhoe and Ivanhoe Waterford Patio homes for the cleaning and painting of exterior walls including the pool house and walls. The quote for Ivanhoe was \$7500 and the quote for Waterford was \$7000. CRS offered a discount if they do both. We are waiting to compare these quotes to the ones Kathryn Saidak is obtaining.

Pool Canopy – it was suggested that we consider purchasing a canopy to add shade to the pool area over the new pavers in what is now the grass area adjacent to the pool house. – Mike to take a look at the one in Falcons Leigh Patio Homes. – **Skip got addl quote for \$8500 – moved area to corner over top of existing tables – permanent structure. Skip proposed we look at Sails or Canvas Covering as a more cost effective solution and will obtain quote.**

Security Measures – Ken to look into and get pricing for faux cameras at pool, with one real camera to take pictures of lic plates and feed into hard drive in pump room. He will also get prices for signs. – It was motioned and accepted that cameras purchased under \$1,000 will not need a board vote. Permission to purchase granted.

Pool Water Level – water level low so not being filtered. Marsha to call Shawn the pool guy to take a look at the water levels
